

References in Germany »Height 1« – Hamburg



Object:

»Hamburg Heights« in Hamburg's Altstadt district enjoys an attractive setting between Jungfernstieg and Hafencity. In 2016 the listed high-rise, which used to be home to Der Spiegel, was refurbished and renamed Height 1. It features 13 overground floors and its equipment has been upgraded to the latest standards. Sustainable concepts and innovative technology have increased the property's value and reduced operating costs. For example: a decentralised hot water supply was chosen featuring electronic mini instantaneous water heaters. The entire 7.100 square metres of rented space is used by commercial law firm Möhrle Happ Luther. While 104 electronic mini instantaneous water heaters perform their work inconspicuously and economically, 14 of CLAGE's Zip HydroTap® drinking water systems make a useful extra feature in the law firm's tea kitchens, supplying convenient drinking water to the company's 240 staff.
